FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

1. I am final year student and yet the final semester exams are not over. What to upload in consolidated marksheet and EQ certificate sections respectively?

You can upload seventh semester marksheet in consolidated marksheet section and Declaration for final year candidate in EQ certificate section. You can find Declaration for final year candidate in download format tab from upper left corner of the screen.

2. I don't have caste certificate (OBC/EWS) of year 2020-2021 (issued on or after 1st April 2020), but I am having the previous year certificate?

You can upload the caste certificate (OBC/EWS) of previous year. But you have to upload the certificate of current year, which is issued on or after 1st april 2020 till 12th October 2020.

- 3. I was applying for the post of scientist B post and the site is asking to upload the ugc net certificate, but I have yet to write NET exam 2020.

 In the place of NET scorecard, you have to upload the NET declaration which is been given in download format section.
- 4. When I enter my CGPA then aggregate percentage is automatically shown in the text box The aggregate % is taken by the formula %=(CGPA-0.75)*10 as per AICTE guidelines, if no conversion formula exists. But it is editable and you can change it according to CGPA to Percentage formula given by your university. If formula exists then you have to upload the existing formula.
- 5. I don't have a GATE score, can I apply under Advt 137. Valid GATE score is mandatory to apply in Advt 137
- 6. I have a degree in X discipline and I also have a valid GATE score. Whether I am eligible to apply?

The degree of the candidates applying against vacancies under Advt. No. 137 must match with the degree mentioned in Essential Qualification or with any of the equivalent acceptable subjects of Qualifying degree as mentioned in our published advertisement.

7. During final submission the lock button is not working or not able to lock Kindly use Chrome/Edge/Firefox for the application. And disable the ad blocker in your system .
